6. Why would Solomon specifically ask that foreigners be accepted too?
7. He quotes "May your eyes be open" a couple times in the text. Are there other instances in the bible where we find this quote?
8. Solomon recognizes that Israel is a chosen nation and they should be held accountable to that. Do we sometimes take for granted that we were chosen as well?
9. Do you think Solomon's attitude and language gives off a positive or negative attitude towards his people? Why?
